

COLUMBIA ZINC DUST PAINT

A rust inhibiting paint containing a high proportion of zinc pigments.

OUTSTANDING FEATURES AND BENEFITS:

Outlasts regular paints by up to four times.

Inhibits rust.

Replaces the zinc that weathers off of galvanized steel.

Covers in one coat.

High zinc content – over 21 pounds per gallon.

One of the most economical paints available on a zinc per square foot basis.

PRIMARY USES:

Galvanized steel.

As a spot primer on rust.

COVERAGE:

One coat coverage.

About 300 square feet per gallon.

About 200 square feet per gallon on corrugated metal.

APPLICATION:

Industrial spray, brush, or heavy (1 inch) nap roller. Paint should be stirred frequently to prevent the heavy zinc pigments from settling.

THINNING:

Thin if necessary with no more than 14 oz of mineral spirits per gallon.



COLUMBIA ZINC DUST PAINT

LIMITATIONS:

This is a very heavy paint that will run under bolt heads when spray applied. Recommended only on rusted areas of previously painted metal. Slow drying, which means more time to penetrate rust and typically waiting 1 to 3 days if top coating.

COLOR:

Light blue-gray

NOTE TO THE PROFESSIONAL:

Tip: .019 to .021 inch
Fan Width: 8 to 10 inches

Pressure: 2000 to 3000 pounds depending on height
